The Alberta Government and the Alberta Energy and Utilities Board (the EUB) say coal bed methane (CBM) is natural gas. But only if it's found beneath Crown lands! Geol., Chairman of FHOA's Technical Committee, will discuss the coal owner's unsubstantiated claims to CBM ownership, how the response of your Government and the EUB to these claims is impacting your property rights, and what you and FHOA can do to prevent your Government from stealing your gas with impunity and supporting the position of the coal owners. Do you understand your royalty statements? Brad Murray, MSc., MBA, P. Eng., FHOA Director and President of Just Freehold Energy (JFEC), will discuss the sad state of industry royalty reporting, how the FHOA Lease used by JFEC addresses the royalty reporting problem and other key aspects of the FHOA Lease. Is the FHOA Lease and Just Freehold Energy making a difference? Jim Harriman, FHOA Director and Chairman of the Board of JFEC will discuss JFEC, its role as the 'freeholders energy company', what JFEC has accomplished to date and JFEC's future. What's next? The FHOA Lease and JFEC were the first steps. Else Pedersen and David Speirs will discuss unsatisfied offset obligations, the formation of Freehold Oil & Gas Services Inc. to address this problem, and other potential services.
