Carol has asked me to contact you with an update from the Energy Minister's Office re: Freehold Owners Association Funding Proposal.

The Energy Department is currently reviewing the proposal and will provide a response directly to the Association in due time.

With that said, the Minister's Office has informed us that the Department of Energy does not have programs that provide grants or other forms of financial assistance to volunteer organizations within the energy industry. In Lieu of any funding, the department will recommend options for non-financial support to the FHOA. They are concerned that providing funding for a particular association may be viewed as being in direct opposition to other members of industry that the department deals with on a daily basis.
